



Samish Cabinetry Design & Delivery Process

Thank you for choosing Samish Cabinetry. We sincerely appreciate the opportunity to help you create a beautiful and functional space. Our team is committed to delivering high-quality craftsmanship and service throughout your project. This document outlines the key steps in our design and delivery process to ensure a smooth and collaborative experience.

Please do not hesitate to reach out if you have any questions or require clarification at any stage.

Step 1: Gather Information

To initiate the design process, we require certain details and documentation, depending on whether you are working with a design professional or utilizing our in-house design services.

If Working with an Architect or Design Professional:

- Scaled floor plans and elevated drawings (minimum requirement to begin design)
- Appliance selections (due by Version 2)
- Finish selections (due by Version 2)
- Cabinet hardware (pull) selections (due by Version 2)
- Lighting details (due by Version 2)
- Special features such as countertops, trim, and crown molding (to be shown in elevation drawings)



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In-House Design Option:

- For clients without professional design plans, Samish Cabinetry offers in-house design services, which may be billed separately.

Step 2: Make the Plan

Our design process includes up to five versions of detailed shop drawings:

1. Version 1 - Preliminary shop drawings created from provided information or in-house design.
2. Version 2 - Revised drawings incorporating feedback from Version 1.
3. Version 3 - Includes updates based on Version 2 comments; all required selections and details must be finalized.
4. Optional In-Person Review - Clients are encouraged to meet at our office to review the project in person and view a 3D model in SketchUp.
5. Version 4 - Incorporates feedback from Version 3 and review meeting; site measurements are verified.
6. Version 5 (Final) - Finalized drawings for sign-off. Changes beyond this version will be billed hourly.

Note: Final plan approval is required before production.



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Step 3: Delivery

Supply-Only Projects:

- Cabinetry is delivered curbside.
- Clients must provide labor to move products to their location.
- Optional handling to the job site interior is available by quote.

Supply and Install Projects:

- Samish Cabinetry handles delivery and installation.
- The following conditions must be met before installation:
 - Clear, open, and accessible workspace
 - Flooring protected (e.g., with Ramboard)
 - Adequate electrical access
 - All rough-in work completed
